Item Description: Ninety-one (91) drilled pearls in a triple strand bracelet with a white and yellow metal clasp marked with a symbol and "925" "585" and set with one (1) additional partially drilled pearl (also tested) and four transparent near-colorless rose cuts: Strand 1) 36 pearls Strand 2) 19 pearls Strand 3) 36 pearls.

Weight: **12.13 grams (gross)**

Measurements: **Ranging from 2.69 mm to 5.63 mm**

Comments: Pearl on the clasp and pearl 1 in strand 2 from the clasp end are bead cultured pearls.
 Pearls are identified and described insofar as mounting/drilling permits analysis.
 Mollusk identification is an expert opinion based on a collection of observations and analytical data.
