Comments: Only five (5) pearls in this bracelet have been tested.
 Cultured pearls grown in the Akoya pearl oyster are routinely bleached.
 Pearls are identified and described insofar as mounting/drilling permits analysis.
 Mollusk identification is an expert opinion based on a collection of observations and analytical data.
